



	Invalid Token Message Spamming Application Event logs

	Decryption calls were being made with a blank token causing a message on the application event log but no impact to the transaction processing. Validation has been added to check the format and only make the decrypt call if it is in the correct token format; thereby, eliminating the message in the application event log.


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
